



The Nebraska State Historical Society Foundation's travel adventure program, **WanderNebraska**, is kicking off its 3rd year! This year the program includes over 195 Nebraska museums, libraries, parks, and other historical points of interest to visit, including 24 new locations!

A map is included in the center of the booklet for you to track your visits. Complete your WanderNebraska map by simply checking off all the sites you visit. Prizes will be mailed out in January 2025. (Be sure to include your contact information in your submission!)
