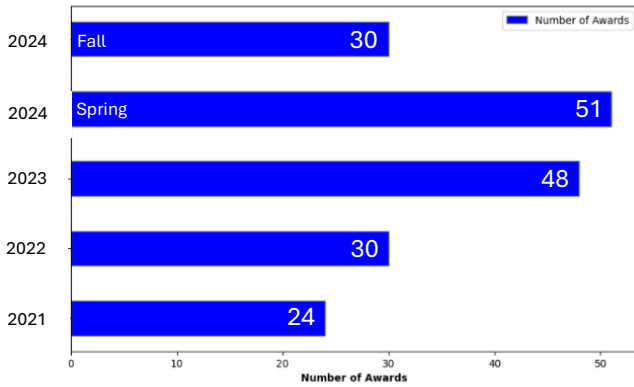


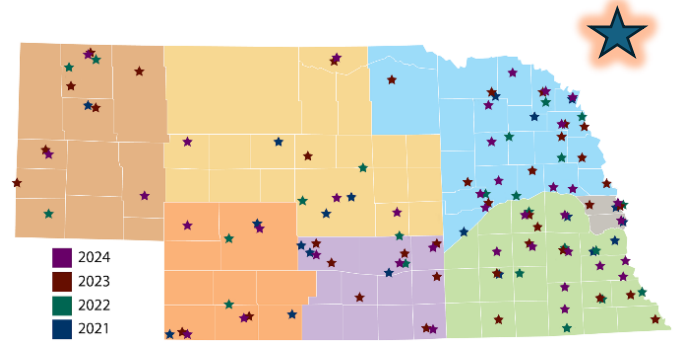
Connecting people with Nebraska history since 1942.

Number of SGP Awards

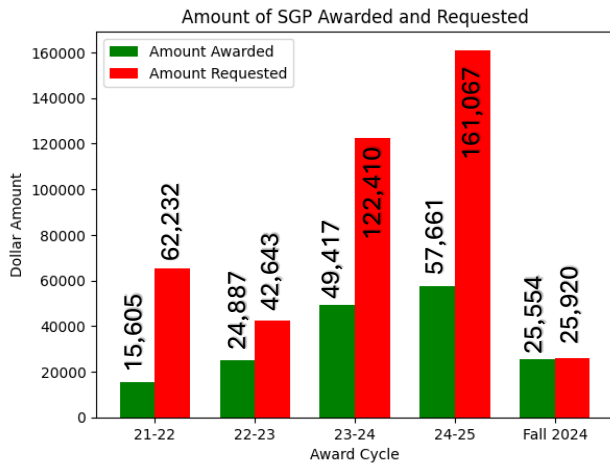


Statewide Grant Locations

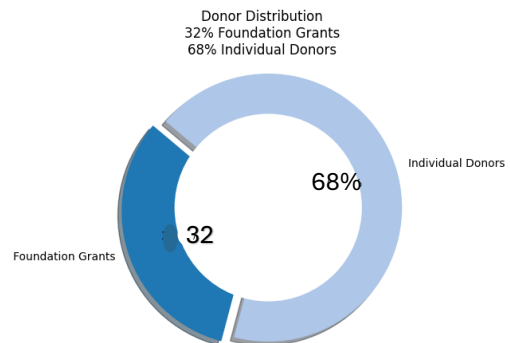


Number of SGP Dollars Awarded Compared to Dollars Requested
