We may not fully fund your request so please seek other funding sources while awaiting our decision. The main focus areas for grant distribution from this program will assist local historical efforts on the part of historical societies, museums, archives, libraries, etc. Grants should be for core educational, preservation and interpretive purposes. A detailed budget or estimates are beneficial. Examples of potential projects are:

- Collection Preservation
- Funding Support for Traveling Exhibits and Speakers
- Publication Support
- Youth and Family Programming •

Milestone Events or Festivals

- School field trips (maximum \$1,000 request)
- Exhibit Production

The Statewide Grant program does not fund: building maintenance and repairs, IRS wages or strategic plans.

Application Information and Deadlines: Submit the completed application with any supporting material including estimates for this grant by March 31, 2025. Grantees will be notified in May 2025. Only one application/project per organization will be considered.

Basic Requirements

- There is no matching fund requirement.
- One application/project per organization per grant cycle.
- A detailed budget is preferred.
- Funds may not be used for building maintenance and repair, IRS wages or strategic plans.
- Funds must be used for the project submitted and expended by May 31, 2026.

Credit

Credit the NSHSF for your project. For example: "This project was supported by a grant from the NSHSF". Include credits in the following circumstances:

- All press and media releases about the project
- Your newsletter and similar publications
- Your website
- Signage if your project entails an exhibit
- Verbal announcement at public gatherings which the grant supports such as an exhibit opening or members' meeting

Final Report

- Due on or before June 30, 2026.
- Include the name of your organization and contact person's email address.
- Description of the work supported by the grant. Include any innovative or noteworthy efforts.
- Name of partnering organizations that collaborated on your project.
- Copies of receipts or accounting records for the expenditure of the grant.
- Photographs of work in progress and the final project. This can even show your work area and equipment purchased, people involved, kick-off events, etc. Please allow us to use these in social media and other publicity. When applicable, please include any press clippings, newsletters, media releases, or links to websites, etc. about your project.
- A short statement describing how this grant benefited your organization and its mission.
- Suggestions or comments for future grants.

The final report is due on or before June 30, 2026. Failure to submit this report will make your organization ineligible for funding for two years.
